Dear Madam,

Thank you for your kind letter of this morning. I know it must be very difficult to post people, so I must just go where you send me.

This morning the Medical Officer of Health called on me, and said I was to be under observation till August 1st, as he had been informed by General Donovan that there was a case of smallpox on board the Hospital Ship Glengorm Castle on which I came home.

I did not know when I came to the War Office on Monday that I was to be under observation, as I never saw the smallpox case at all. I am enclosing a copy of the memorandum sent to Captain Weston.
