Just a line thanking you for the past care hope this will find you both in the pink as it leave me the same

At present we aint heard anything about shifting yet but still we don't care about that we aint in any hurry we are having some hot weather now. I suppose you are having the same they have started harvesting down this way fancy the war being on two years now it don't seem true does it. Sammy knows where I was that day that war was declared C.. Paite has been home on his final leave. I hear young H Mercer is killed its hard luck for is parents aint it being the only boy. I went down to Gravesend last Saturday and I heard about it down there. Its funny how you hear about things but I dropped in with a Bexhill postman and he told me about him he said he was Cousin to him I see by the Chronicle that Daz aint got very long theres very [good?] photo of the two Sargents in there I think I must soon close or I shant catch the post I heard from Nell she told me Tom was gone off the Club
