Dear Nance and Sammy,

I received the parcel quite safe thanks very much for it the plums were lovely and so was the cucumber I aint got a lot of news to tell you we had the Zepps over the other night & they came over the camp we couldn't see them for it was too thick we heard them very plain they done a good bit of damage round London they dropped a few bombs not far away from us only about 3 miles so that was plenty close enough they dropped a good many bombs. There was a tidy racket for a little while I can tell you. They fairly lit the place up when they burst we are having a good bit of wet now I heard Tom Smith was home at Catsfield C Waite was here last weekend and he told me. He said they cant hear anything about F. Winchester I don't think there is any more news just now

So I will close hoping this will find you both in the best of health as it leave me so at present
