well Nance there aint a lot of news to tell you just remember me to all I am sorry to here about poor Alf his father is pretty much upset about it aint he you ought to see my Charley mucy (moustache?) not half you might have the chance too I shant cut it off now. Now I think I will close hoping this will find you both in the best of health as it leave me so at present
