Dear Nance and Samy

Just a few lines in answer to your letter which I received on the 21st I am send you an handkerchief which you said you would like to have I hope you will like it and let me know if you get it alright I expect you will by sending it in a registered envelope I expect the strawberrys are over with now Mum said you went fruit-picking. I should like to have had a nice feed not half we are having a few new potatoes now its no use sending out anything of that kind for we are just beginning to get some I had a letter from Uncle Ben the other day he is still in the pink and a paper he sent me to read the account of Lady Webster that was sad wasn't it. I saw it in the Chronicle, who is that W.Harmer I saw in the Chronicle wounded from Ninfield in the Essex Regt I thought it must be Stephen as you told me while back that he was wounded.

well Nance I don't think there is any more news this time

hoping this will find you both in the best of health as it leaves me at present from
