CONCEALED HIS WOUNDS

Private G. R. H. Jones, Royal West Kents, eldest son of Mr and Mrs Jones, of 5, Camperdown Street, Sidley, who recently returned home, is under treatment at the V.A.D. Hospital in Cantelupe Road. He was wounded in the leg by bullets from a Lewis gun at the time of his capture but, not liking the idea of being lanced by German surgeons, and having only light work, he concealed the extent of his wounds and treated them himself as well as he was able.

Private Jones, who is only 20 years of age, was transferred from the Royal Sussex Regiment to the Royal West Kents.
