During June the following articles were made and dispatched:-

Surgical - 195 many tailed bandages. 315 roller bandages, 60 eye bandages, 60 shell dressings, 55 gauge swabs, 60 splints, ten pairs operation stockings, 90 Davis slings, nine surgeon's veils.

Made from old linen sheets, pillow cases, tablecloths etc.\_\_\_ 15 small pillows and cases, 20 feeders, 10 handkerchiefs, 15 bed pan covers, 10 operation table sheets, 15 tray cloths, 5 dressing cloths, 5 large pillow cases.

Other materials: - 14 dressing gowns, 15 night shirts, 6 pairs pyjamas, 12 bed jackets, 10 ward bags, 10 hot water bottle covers, 15 knitted scrubbers, 30 knitted face swabs, 20 antivermin vests and pants, 7 pairs slippers.
