11 Dec 1915: Enlisted at Hastings (St. Leonards) aged 27years 6 months.

 Height 5ft 10 ins, Weight 10st 12lbs, Chest girth when fully expanded
 38 ins, Physical development Good.

04 May 1916: Embarked at Southampton.

05 May 1916: Disembarked at Le Havre.

11 May 1916: Mobilised to 3rd/2nd H.C. Brigade, Royal Field Artillery.

18 Aug 1916: Inoculated

01 Sep 1916: Inoculated again.

11 Sep 1916: Vaccinated.

04 Oct 1916: Joined British Expeditionary Force with 109 Battery 283rd^l Brigade.

18 Oct 1916 Wounded in the field.

15 Nov 1916 Returned to unit.

02 Jan 1917 Wounded in the field.

20 Jan 1917 Discharged to duties.

01 Mar 1917 Granted leave to UK until 10 Mar 1917

17 Mar 1917 Returned to unit.

10 Sep 1917 With 12th Anti-Aircraft Battery on course.

14 Sep 1917 Wounded in the field.

22 Sep 1917 Returned to duty.

19 Jan 1918 Granted leave to UK until 02 Feb 1918.

31 Jan 1918 Admitted to hospital in England with disease.

20 Mar 1918 Discharged to re-join unit.

09 April 1919 Posted to HQ Germany

29 Aug 1919	Codford discharge Medical examination passed.
01 Jun 1919	Posted to Highlanders/DAC
09 Jun 1919	Granted leave to UK via Calais until 23 June 1919.
30 Aug 1919	Despatched to concentration camp for dispersal Codford.
31 Aug 1919	At Crystal Palace for 28 days for dispersal with Highland DAC unit.
