## COOMBE FARM AND COTTAGE

## **DETAILS OF PROPERTY (NGR TQ 755 097)**

A small holding within the Manor of Buckholt.

Coombe Cottage, now demolished, was once part of Coombe Farm which was later absorbed into Glovers Farm. It was built before 1839 and can be seen on the Tithe Map as Coombe Cottage. (1)

There are no descriptions of the cottage as it was demolished at the turn of the twentieth century when the Crowhurst line from Sidley was built. To find the site today you can walk along the track leading from Upper Worsham Farm to Actons Farm, drop down through Coombe Wood, under the railway arch and the cottage would have been just after the arch on the right hand side, almost on the marsh.
