<1802>	Described in a Rental as Eastlands. Sire Horatio Mann owner 30a (8)
<1808>	Sire Horation Mann owner, William Duke tenant 37a (3)
<1833>	Edward Millward ESQ leaseholder, Samuel Holland tenant (5)
<1843>	Earl of Cornwallis owner, Samuel Holland tenant (4)
<1877-1913>	Earl of Cornwallis owner, John Weston and William Duke tenants until atleast 1909. 36 acres and all pasture.
1913 Aug 30	Mr John Weston rented this farm from the Cornwallis Estate for 36 years and he is almost 80 years old. He has been connected with Collington Farm where he spent 8 years and Sandhurst Lodge for 12 years, also Kites Nest. 36 acres and all pasture. (9)
