PROPERTY DETAILS

In the early 19th century this small holding was in the ownership of the Sampson family. Richard King of Alfriston and Willingdon lately Richard King Sampson left all to John Hammond later known as John Hammond Sampson. On the deed of 1st Feb 1816 as 'Cottage, barn, gardens and pieces of land called Sandmares, one piece of woodland called Sandmares or St Mary's Wood now in the occupation of Richard King Sampson and residue in the occupation of John Wright, which were purchased in 1763 by Richard Sampson the son from John Thomas' (1)
