Bechill I saw Jas Care give the Blow - he came up to me afterwards  
I took up a pair of Tubs in Mr Brooks's yard <sup>he said he had given</sup>  
Fred Daniels & W Daniels were both at <sup>collins of imperial the</sup> Bechill with

think it was = The Bats were taken out of the Waggon  
a house ~~at~~ on Severney between there and Eastbourne just  
af we got the other side of the Gate we took the arms  
out = The Muskets were carried to Cuthbert's house  
Maynard's house the Wheelwright via Sack The Bats  
were left = The Tubs were covered with Straw  
Made no stop at Hailsham = We stopped at a  
public Ho - They were counted on the Road out of  
the Waggon = and carried into a wood - I went  
into Maynard's house. put <sup>the Muskets</sup> in the stable place just  
beside his house in the Manger - never saw Bats  
<sup>put away</sup> was paid by Cuthbert & Maynard 30/- for that night  
work = were all paid 30/- the Batmen =  
= 2 women served them with Beer - I was employed  
by Thos Maynard & Cuthbert = Started from Newfield  
10 or 12 together at the Public House we all met the  
whole Company = All the before mentioned Batmen  
went down to the Steps = Muskets were similar  
to those used by the Blockade,
